## Google Apps for Education (GAFE)

Gmail - Used for communication among classmates, teachers and the District as well as for instructional purposes Google Drive - Used to store files, collaborate with students and teachers, create projects Chrome - Used for storing bookmarks, installing apps (web resources), saving history. Once you are logged into Chrome, you must log off to stop recording your history.

Students can export their Google account upon graduation or leaving the district.
